

ACTION ITEM: ARMBAND



Make it and share with others:

- 1. Cut out a piece of black fabric (felt works best) 18 inches wide x 4 inches high.
- 2. Print out this page, and glue the fish stencil to a piece of thin cardboard. A cereal box works great for making stencils, or you can use poster board.
- 3. Use an Xacto knife or small scissors to cut out the stencil. Cut out the black parts, leaving the background intact. Don't worry about the eye, you will add it later.
- 3. Place the stencil on top of the center of the black fabric.
- 4. Use a sponge to apply white, non-toxic paint to the fabric through the opening in the stencil. We do not recommend using spray paint. Acrylic artist paint works best. Don't thin it too much.
- 5. After the fish is done, use a waterproof marker to draw in the eye.
- 6. Pin on with a safety pin. Wear your armband to show your support for the river and lagoon. Share with others!
